

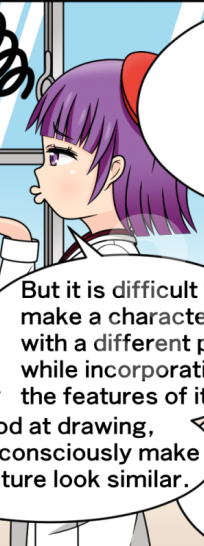
Your suggestion may cause copy-right trouble...

Are anime character traits copyrighted?



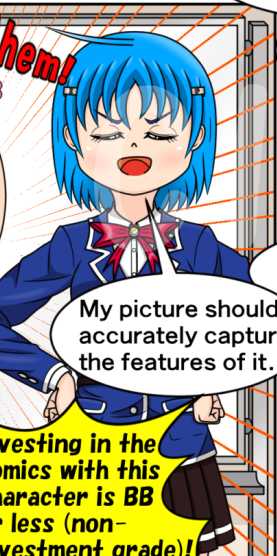
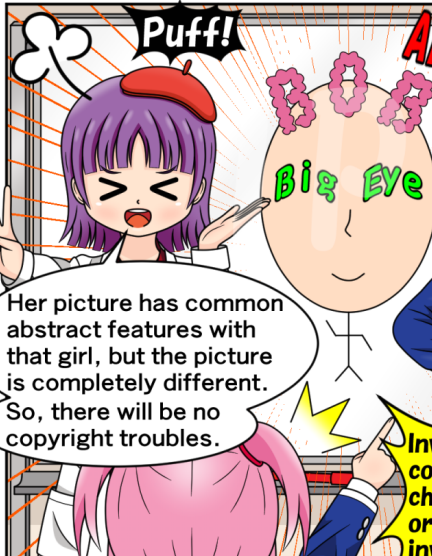
OK. You're bad at drawing, please design the character.
