

Keep her steady!

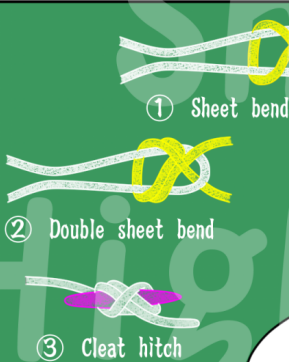
I became 16 years old the other day, so I got a license as a "2nd class boat's operator"★
