Do sports like martial arts also fall under the category of performing?

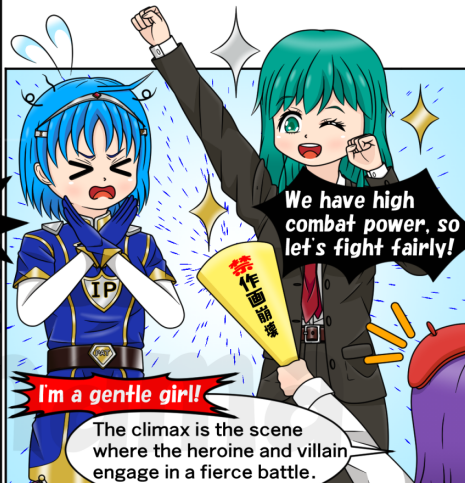
Sports generally don't fall under the category of "performing". This is because it's not a performance of a work, and it's not having the nature of a performing art.

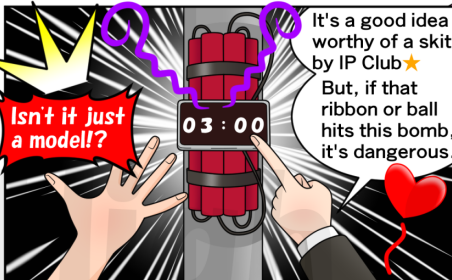

The climax is the scene where the heroine and villain engage in a fierce battle.



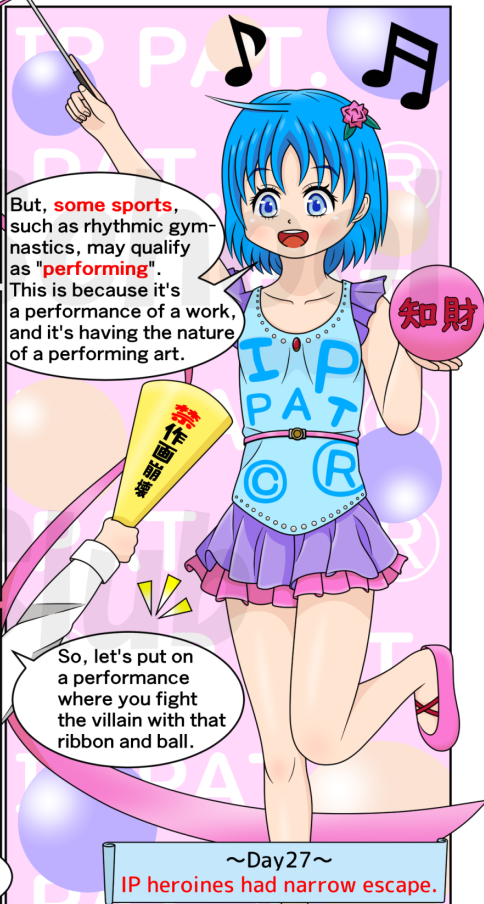
Isn't it just a model!?
