Umm...

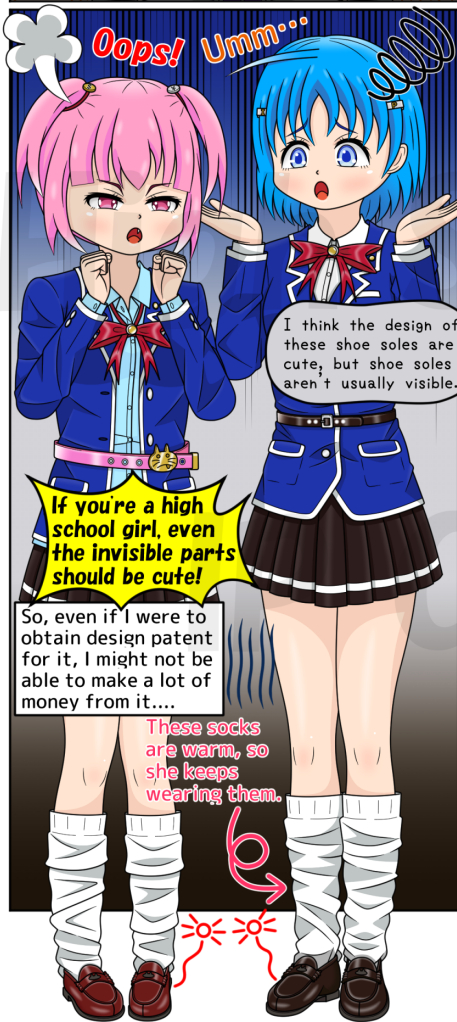


But Misube-chan is an exception as she doesn't even wear a uniform....

~Day36~ A must-have item for Japanese high school girls!?



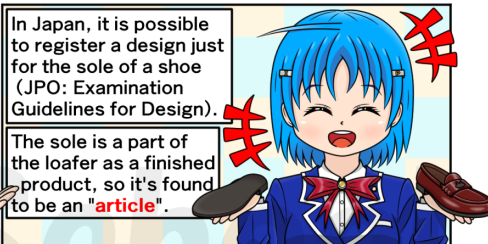
Oops! Umm...

Because shoe sole is interchangeable and is traded as an independent product in a normal trading state.
