This is because a picture drawn by setting beans doesn't fall under the category of design since it doesn't have a specific shape (JPO: Examination Guidelines for Design).



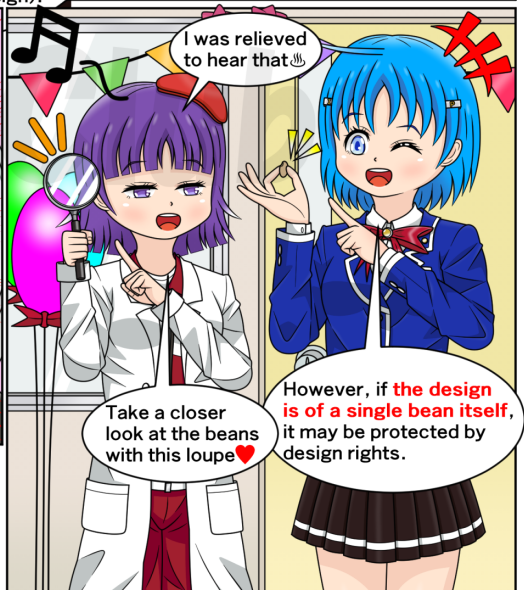
Hey. Will Japanese Design Act protect such a design?
