Btw, okoshi is a collection of grains of rice.

So, it is not possible to obtain design patents for the Okoshi design in Japan?

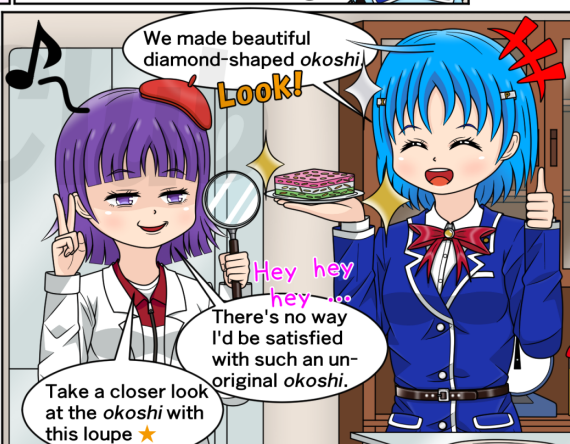
No. A collection of granules that can maintain a fixed shape can be registered as a design (JPO: Examination Guidelines for Design).



Each of these many grains of rice has Chinako's face drawn on it, which has a different expression!
