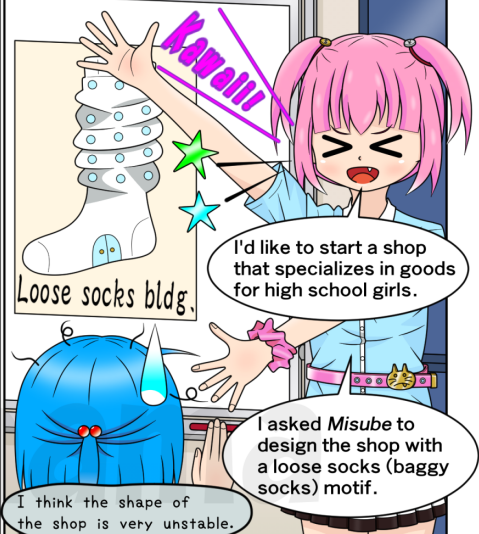




In order to qualify as a building design, it must be a **fixture on the land.**

I think the shape of the shop is very unstable.



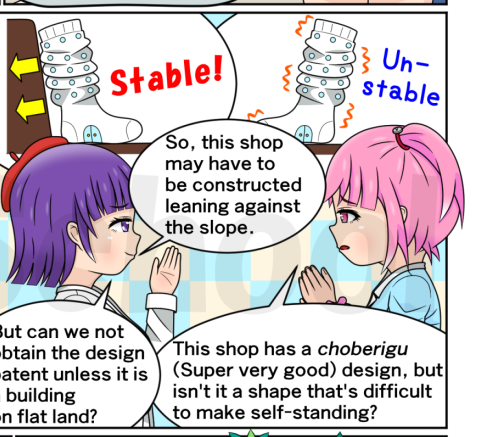
Flat land OK!

Don't worry, the terrain in which your shop is located doesn't matter.



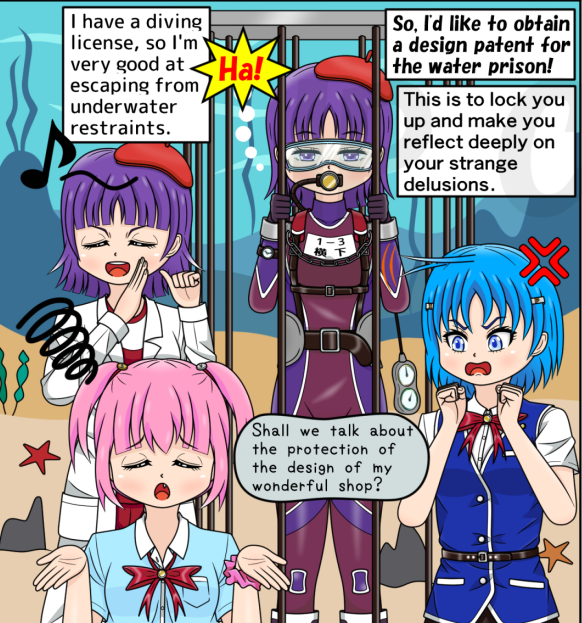
Stable!
