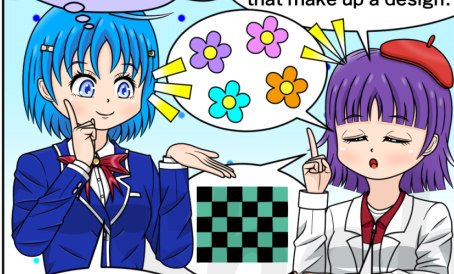


This checkered pattern is the symbol of Japanese famous manga character.
